Job Description

Reports To: Production Manager

Starting Pay: \$15/hour

Summary: Responsible for the operation of the plant, working a 12-hour rotating shift schedule, to ensure maximum production quantity and quality, while supporting the policies, goals and objectives of the company.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include the following: Other duties may be assigned.

- Work well in a team environment.
- Monitors, controls, and records plant operations.
- Samples, tests, and records process streams as required by the QA program and procedures.
- Performs preventive maintenance activities and assist maintenance technicians in performing maintenance and repairs.
- Participates in safety, health and environmental programs.
- Works in safe manner at all times.
- Participates in programs and procedures required to ensure plant cleanliness.
- Must be willing to work overtime when needed.

Schedule:

- 12 hour shifts alternating between days and nights.

Skills:

- Experience in the operation of a dry-mill ethanol plant is an asset
- Simple readings, writing and math skills are required.
- Must have the ability to learn and work effectively with the plant's Distributed Control System (DCS).
- Mechanical experience is an asset.

Physical Requirements:

- The employee must regularly lift and/or move up to 50#.
- Must be able to climb ladders and work at elevations 175 feet.

Working Environment:

- The employee is regularly exposed to moving mechanical parts.
- The employee is regularly exposed to dusty conditions.
- The employee is regularly exposed to high noise environments.
- The employee is regularly exposed to outside weather in all conditions.
- The employee will regularly be exposed to chemicals used in the process.
